INSTRUCTIONS.

This book must be with you always, when on duty or in court.

First describe the location and boundary of your beat.

Patrolmen—Enter every arrest you make. State on what charge, name of the party and prosecuting witness; also place of residence, date and hour. Note when you are absent from duty and the cause. Enter all fires or alarms that occur in your beat and probable amount of damage done at the time.

Enter all notorious houses located in your beat, where notorious characters congregate, and give full description of them, if any are about, and notify your Lieutenant at once of this fact.

Detectives—Note every special case assigned you, and generally what duty you have been on every day, and all arrests made by or through you. Report at headquarters every twenty-four hours the progress of your cases.

Lieutenants—You will examine all these books in your district every twenty-four hours by signing your name and date officially. Note all suspensions or matter of special interest daily, and report to headquarters at once all suspicious characters reported or known to you.

No one shall make an entry in this book except the officer to whom it belongs. This book must be kept clean and neat.

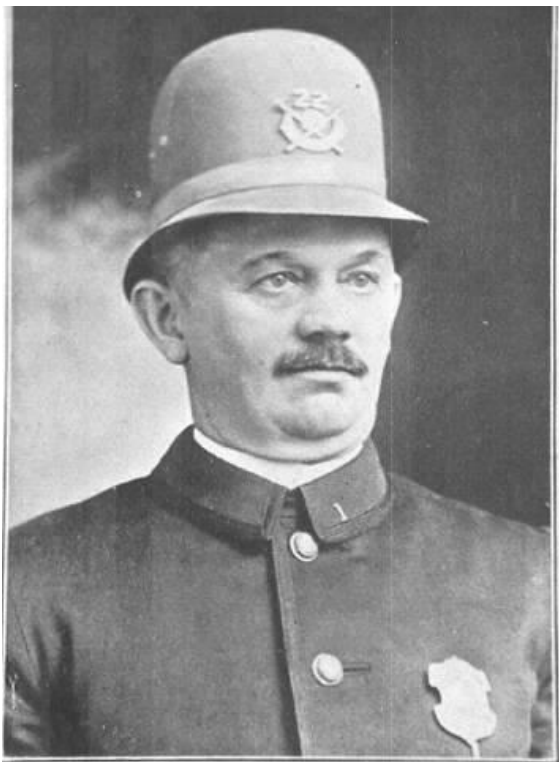
