

Police Officer Gene Edward Ragan (YOB-2016)

Gene was born in Hamilton, Ohio on October 16, 1939 to Hamilton Patrolman Crabill and Negil (Bryant) Ragan. He attended Hamilton High School, playing football and joining Junior Achievement and the History Club. He graduated in 1958 and then went on to serve in the United States Navy until 1965.



Gene joined the Fairfield Township Police Department as a Patrolman and retired in 2005.

He then worked for and retired from the Hamilton City Water Plant.

Officer Ragan died on September 9, 2016 at the age of 76.
