

# Telecommunications Manager Ronald William Bien (1952-2019)

Ron was born June 24, 1952 in Cincinnati to Cletus William and Sylvia Ann (Schmidt) Bien.

He joined the Springfield Township Police Department as a Police Clerk in the late 1960s. He later was promoted to Police Officer.
