

Patrolman Thomas Eugene “Gene” Britton (1936-2017)

Tom was born on March 26, 1936 to Ezra H. and Ethel E. Britton of Union Township. He Graduated from Sharonville High School.



Tom joined the Ohio State Patrol and graduated the Patrol Academy on July 1957. He was posted at Portsmouth. Later, he transferred to Hamilton. During August 1962, Patrolman Britton was drafted into the United State Army. After serving two years, he returned to the Patrol at the Norwalk Post.

Patrolman Britton was then hired as a Patrolman by Monroeville near Sandusky on April 8, 1964. He resigned on July 31st of the same year.

Tom moved to Mason where he lived the rest of his life. He joined the Mason Police Department and served as a volunteer firefighter and life squad Captain.

He gave up police work and entered the insurance business, from which he retired.

Patrolman Britton passed away on Thursday, November 16, 2017.
