

Lieutenant Daniel Anthony Cash, Sr. (1933-2017)

Dan was born January 20, 1933 in Cincinnati, the middle of 3 sons born to Lacon and Catherine Cash. His first job was running a newspaper delivery route when he was 8 years old. He attended Immaculata High School.

At the age of 17, Dan joined the United States Air Force on February 14, 1950. He served as a parachute rigger and radio controlled drone pilot at Chanute and McDill Air Force Bases. Staff Sergeant Cash was honorably discharged on September 14, 1953.

Between his discharge and mid-1954, Dan worked as a plumber's helper, freight handler, and grinder.



Dan joined the Cincinnati Police Division as a Police Recruit on July 11, 1954. He was promoted to Patrolman October 11, 1954, issued Badge Number 44, and assigned to District 7 (813 Beecher Street). He also served in District 1 (310 Lincoln Park Drive) and District 2 (314 Broadway). He was promoted to Sergeant on March 14, 1965, issued Badge Number S-57, and transferred to District 5 (1012 Ludlow Avenue). He also served in District 2 and Traffic Bureau. On May 24, 1970 Sergeant Cash was transferred Robbery Squad in the Criminal Investigation Section. On October 24, 1971, he was promoted to Lieutenant, issued Badge Number L-48, and transferred to District 1. On February 20, 1972 Lieutenant Cash was assigned as the Homicide Unit Commander. He graduated from the FBI National Academy during March 29, 1974. During 1978, he was appointed as the Administrative Assistant in the Operations Bureau and a year later transferred to District 4 (4150 Reading Road). Lieutenant Cash retired on July 2, 1983 retired with 32½ years of service to his country and community and 37 letter of appreciation and/or commendation; including 13 from various Police Chiefs, the City Manager, and Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Daniel retired to a quiet life in rural Babson Park, Florida, where he enjoyed rebuilding antique cars, and exploring local garage sales.

Lieutenant Cash died on May 4, 2017.

He was predeceased in 2004 by his brother, Cincinnati Police Sergeant Thomas L. Cash. Lieutenant Cash is survived by his sons, Daniel Anthony (Annmarie) Cash, Jr., and David Allen (Lucinda Crites) Cash; grandchildren, Jenna Cash, Chloe Cash, Lauren Cash, and Cameryn Cash; and younger brother, Robert 'Bobby' Cash.
