

Police Officer Timothy Mark Liggett (1958-2019)

Tim was born May 11, 1958 to Archie O. “Arch” and Phylena W. (Wright) Liggett.

He served as a volunteer fire fighter and and emergency medical technician in Withamsville and North Union Fire Departments for thirteen years.

Tim joined the Union Township Police Department on December 4, 1985 where he served as a DARE Office and patrol officer. During 1988, he earned an award for safe driving. During May 1994, the Clermont County Citizens Law Enforcement Association honored Officer Liggett with an award for bravery for evacuating residents of a burning home in 1993. He retired August 21, 2002 with dozens of years of service to his community.



Officer Liggett was also heavily involved with the Masonic Lodge and the Syrian Shriners.

He passed away Sunday, March 24, 2019, at the age of 60.

He was predeceased by his grandchildren Caden, Monroe and Corbin. Officer Liggett is survived by his wife of 17 years, Angela R. (Martin) Liggett; daughters, Kristen Barber, Kellye Liggett, Stephanie (Scott) Lloyd, Jessica (Sean) Smith, Rachael Hager, and Rebecca Hager; grandchildren, Macy, Parker, Laine, Morgan, Makenna, Myles, and Marla; and siblings, Ross Strickland and Elizabeth Gutman.
