

Deputy Theodore "Ted" R. Lyttle Jr. (1942-2019)

Ted was born December 26, 1942 in Blanchester to Theodore "Roy" and Ethel J. (Jones) Lyttle, Sr. He worked alongside his father at the family farm in Wayne Township his family's Standard Oil Company station. He attended Blanchester High School and graduated in 1960.

After high school, Ted enlisted in the Ohio Army National Guard.

He then joined the Clermont County Sheriff's Office and served as a Deputy Sheriff for many years.
