Gene was born January 6, 1932 to United States Post Office truck driver Louis A and Eva C. (Rotsching) Meister of St. Bernard.



Gene enlisted in the United States Air Force and served during the Korean War. While still enlisted, he married Zettarose Marie Mack on January 30, 1953.

Gene joined the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office as a Deputy during December 1980. He left during January 1992 with 11 years of service.

Deputy Meister was a longtime member of the Kolping Society, Veteran of Foreign Wars Elmwood Post 1042, and American Legion Post 199, and a longtime volunteer of Union Terminal and Christ Hospital Chaplain's office.
