
## Captain Jack E. Menninger (1928-2019)

Jack was born October 5, 1928 in Cincinnati. He enlisted in the United States Army during World War II on March 1, 1946 and served as a paratrooper in the Airborne Division.

He joined the Newport Police Department as a patrolman on February 24, 1955. After 1961, he was promoted to sergeant and in the fall of 1963 to lieutenant. He was promoted to captain in 1972. Captain Menninger retired about 1978.

He joined the Northern Kentucky University Department of Public Safety. About 1990, He finally retired with 39 years of service to his country, community, and Northern Kentucky University.
