

Police Specialist Michael Timothy Moore, PS-56 (1941-2017)

Michael was born in Phoenix on November 18, 1941 to dairy farmers Ivan and Dollie (Joy) Moore. He attended the Independence Bible College in Independence, Kansas for two years and God's Bible School and College in Cincinnati, majoring in History and Psychology. He received a Bachelor of Science degree at the University of Cincinnati.

While attending God's Bible School, he also worked there as an assistant purchasing agent and in Maintenance. Beginning 1960, he worked as an orderly at The Christ Hospital and Holmes Hospital until December 1962.

Mike joined the Cincinnati Police Division as a Police Cadet on December 31, 1962. On April 23, 1963, he was promoted to Patrolman, issued Badge Number 761, and assigned to District 6 (Erie Avenue). On March 17, 1964, Patrolman Moore was inducted into the military and returned four months later. On July 23, 1967, he was transferred to District 2 (Broadway). On May 26, 1968, he was promoted to Police Specialist, issued Badge PS-56, and transferred to District 6. Specialist Moore also served in the Tactical Unit (1968), District 4 (Vine Street), Central Warrant Processing, District 2 (Erie Avenue), Communications Section (Ezzard Charles Drive), and District 5 (Ludlow Avenue). Specialist Moore retired January 3, 1990 with 27 years of service and 36 letters of appreciation and/or commendation.

Specialist Moore passed away 9:20 a.m. on Friday, January 6th, 2017 at the Dearborn County Hospital on January 6, 2017 at the age of 75.

He was predeceased by his siblings, Danny Moore and Sarah Moore. Specialist Moore is survived by his wife, 27½ years, Joyce (Peters) Moore; sons, Thomas Moore and Jonathan Moore; 5 grandsons; and siblings, Rebecca Robinson, Nancy Koller, Malcolm Moore, Clinton Moore, and Carl Moore.

Private services were held on January 11, 2017 in Rising Sun, Indiana.
