

Patrolman Richard A. Overbee Sr. (1929-2019)

Richard was born April 21, 1929 in Beattyville, Kentucky to Audie, a carpenter, and Grace (Caudill) Lucas.

He joined the United States Air Force and served during the Korean War.



He then joined the Norwood Police Department as a patrolman.

Later, he took a position at Crosley Broadcasting. Then, he started a landscaping company. Still later, he joined the Cincinnati Post and then the Cincinnati Enquirer as a district circulation manager; from which he finally retired.

Patrolman Overbee was a resident of the Ohio Veterans Home in Georgetown, Ohio. He died peacefully with his daughter and granddaughter at his side, on Wednesday, June 12, 2019 at the age of 90.
