## Police Chief Eugene "Gene" Robinson (1932-2018)

Gene was born March 1, 1932 in Lockland; the 6<sup>th</sup> of 7 children born to Ernest B. and Lenora Robinson. He attended Lockland High School, graduating about 1950.
