Sergeant Merle E. Stethem (1934-2017)

Merle was born March 16, 1934 in Middletown to Samuel and Anna (Borders) Stethem, attended Middletown High School, competing in Track, and graduated in 1952.

Immediately after high school, he enlisted in the United States Navy and served as a Seabee during the Korean War.
