

Police Officer Chester L. Teetor (1951-2017)

Chester was born on May 24, 1951 in Cincinnati to Chester A. and Bessie Teetor. He attended Withrow High School, graduating in 1969. He then attended Cincinnati State Technical and Community College. On December 18, 1971, he married Lana Rogers, his high school sweetheart.

Chester worked for the Cincinnati Enquirer delivering newspapers at night and would function often as eyes and ears for the neighborhoods along his route.

During 1989, Chester joined the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and worked there until 2007. He then took a position as a Police Officer at the Cincinnati State Technical and Community College. He retired during 2012 with 23 years in law enforcement.

Officer and Mrs. Teetor moved to Burlington to raise Alpacas.

On December 22, 2017, Officer Teetor was experiencing extreme shoulder, neck, and head pain. He sought help, lost consciousness in the emergency room, and was put on life support. He passed away on December 27, 2017 from what was determined to be bleeding on the brain. He was 66.

Officer Teetor is survived by his wife of 46 years, Lana R. (Rogers) Teetor; children, Krista Teetor, Amy (Ryan) Chupka, and Randy Teetor; grandchildren, Jacob, Logan, Brenden, CJ, Ava, and Aiden; great-grandchildren, Xavier and Isaiah; and siblings, Cindy DePuccio, Edie (Randy) Lotz, and Martha Weber.
