

# Woodrow Consley "Woody" Snow (1942-2019)

Woody was born on August 1, 1942 in Covington to Woodrow and Nelda Snow.

Woody joined the Elsmere Police Department on April 4, 1970 as a Patrolman. On April 21, 1980, he joined the Greater Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky Airport Police Department.



While there, he was a member of the Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Team. A crack shot, he won several awards for shooting. He was their first Mounted Officer and Motorcycle Police Officer. Officer Snow then worked for the Boone County Sheriff's Office. He retired after serving his community for 36 years.

He was also a past 32° Mason and Shriner.

Officer Snow, surrounded by his family, died on December 16, 2019 at the age of 77.

He was predeceased by his sister, Pixie Gillum.
