Sergeant Morris K. Johns (1950-2020)

Morris was born on May 23, 1950 to Carl and Maudie (Sammons) Johns.

He joined the Bellevue Police Department as a Patrolman. On September 27, 1974 Patrolman Johns completed a basic training course conducted by the Kentucky State Justice Department Bureau of Training.
