

Police Chief Robert Fisher (1969 - 2023)

Robert joined the Sharonville Police Department on May 1, 1993 as a police officer. He served as a patrol officer and DARE Officer.

Officer Fisher joined the United States Coast Guard Reserves in 2001. He and served as a Petty Officer, including during 2003 with the United States Navy during Operation Iraqi Freedom. He was honorably discharged in 2009.

He was promoted to Administrative Sergeant, then before 2004 to Lieutenant. By 2008, Lieutenant Fisher was serving as the Deputy Safety Service Director.



Lieutenant Fisher left Sharonville to accept a position as Deputy Chief of Police of Hilliard Police Department in 2012. He was promoted to Police Chief in 2015. On May 19, 2016 he had the tragic duty to preside over the ceremonies of the only line of duty death in Hilliard history. Chief Fisher retired in 2021 with 28 years of service to his country, Sharonville, and Hilliard.

Chief Fisher was recently diagnosed with cancer and lost his battle on March 3, 2023.
